## ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

#### **B.Sc.** (Nursing) course:

- ▶ 10+2 class passed in science stream (PCB) and English core/English elective with aggregate of 50% marks from recognizes board under (AISSCE/CBSE/ ICSE/SSCE/HSCE) or other Equivalent Board.
- Both male and female candidates are eligible for admission in B.Sc. Nursing course.
- Minimum age for admission shall be 17 years.
- Candidate must be medically fit.
- A selection test (CEE) will be conducted by the SSUHS. Candidate must score the cut-off mark or above to get admission to B.Sc Nursing

#### Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) course:

- Candidate must be a citizen of India.
- Candidate must be medically fit.
- Must passed GNM with 50% from recognized Institute by INC and approved by the State.
- Must be registered with the State Nursing Council.

#### **General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) course:**

- Both male and female candidates are eligible for admission in GNM course.
- Minimum educational requirement shall be H.S. (10+2) passed from recognized Board (AISSCE /CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other Equivalent Board preferably in science with minimum 45% will be preferred. However, candidates with arts are also eligible to apply.
- Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Govt. and National Institute of Open School (NOIS) recognized by Central Govt.
- Candidates must attain the age of 17 years at the time of admission and should not be more than 35 years.
- 5% relaxation is permitted to SC & ST students.
- Students shall be medically fit.
- Registered ANM with pass mark.

#### ANM (Auxiliary Nurses Midwives) Course:

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- The maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
- Minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 in any stream, passing out from a recognized board.
- Students shall be medically fit.



#### **BPT (Bachelor in Physiotherapy) Course:**

#### 4 years course + 6 month compulsory internship.

- 10+2 passed having English as a subject in science stream with Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) as mandatory subjects with minimum of 60% marks from recognized Board/Council.
- A candidate should have completed the age of 17 years as on 31st December of the year of admission to B.P.T. Degree Course.
- Every candidate must furnish a medical certificate of physical fitness from authorised Government Medical Officer certifying that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the Physiotherapy course before admission.
- Selection criteria for admission shall be normally on merit basis.

#### **SCOPE**

- Placement in both State and Central Govt. Hospitals and Multi-speciality Hospitals in India and abroad.
- Once qualified, a Physiotherapist can work in multispecialty hospitals, rehabilitation centres, in sports and fitness centres.
- Opting for private practice and by setting up private clinics, physiotherapists can treat a variety of patients.
- Due to globalization, there is a wide range of demand for physiotherapists in our country to work in large corporate sectors and industries which provide health care delivery centres for their employees. They can have 'on the spot study' of employees at work places and provide ergonomic advices to them to avoid physical pain associated with particular posture and type of work.
- Some graduates may like to acquire post graduate qualification in various specializations like Physiotherapy in Musculoskeletal and sports, Neurological conditions, cardio respiratory conditions, Paediatrics & Child Health, Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Community Based Rehabilitation and work as teaching faculties in different institutions of physiotherapy and train the young students in the art and science of physiotherapy.
- Graduates can pursue their job abroad with the fulfilment of eligibility criteria due to its large demand and requirements, and also can work as teachers in different institutions of physiotherapy.
- Physiotherapy in sports Sports and Exercise Physiotherapists are involved in the prevention and management of injuries from sport and exercise participation at all ages and at all levels of ability.



#### **BMLT (B.Sc. in Medical Laboratory Technology) - 3 year Degree Course:**

- 10+2 having English as a subject in Science stream with Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) as mandatory subjects with minimum of 60% marks from recognized Board/ Council.
- Selection criteria for admission shall be normally on merit basis.







#### **TEACHING BLOCK:**

There are sufficient state of art classrooms, demonstration/practical rooms, library, visitor's waiting rooms, computer and audio-visual rooms. Each room is well furnished. At NEPNI, we have well ventilated and furnished spacious Lecture Halls and classrooms with necessary audio-visuals aids for better delivery of teaching by faculties.



#### **LABORATORIES:**

As per the norms of Indian Nursing Council, the institute has put in place good laboratory with all equipment and facilities for the students such as –

a) eq

equipped with all the facilities for practicing the basic procedures of Nursing Foundation and Medical Surgical Nursing. Patient's bed, Manikin, models along with other necessary equipment and articles are available for student's practice.

**b) Community Health Laboratory:** This laboratory is constructed for the purpose of learning the basic skills required for Community set-up. Community bags, instruments and articles, models, sample of charts and posters for health teaching etc are available to serve the purpose.



c) OBG and Pediatric Laboratory: All the procedures related to maternal and child health is to be taught in this Laboratory. Provision of Labour Table, Resuscitation equipment, Models and other obstetrical and Gynaecological instruments, paediatric instruments like infant meter, growth assessment charts are available for the students for practicing the basic procedures.

**d) Pre-Clinical Science Laboratory:** This will be used to instruct the students about Anatomy and Physiology, other biological topics with the specimen and Models for better understanding.



e) Nutrition Laboratory: The nutrition lab is furnished and equipped with work tables, cooking stoves. Gas connections, wash basins with running water supply, cutlery, trays, plates, diet scales, cooking utensils racks, pressure cooker and storage room for all provisional items.

**f) Anatomy Laboratory:** This lab contain all necessary boneset, skeletons and charts for easy understanding of the subject. The laboratory is well furnished.



**g) Physiotherapy Laboratory:** Well-equipped physiotherapy lab offers wide range of services for Shoulder, Hand, Knee and Spine, Obesity and Fitness in addition to Incontinence Exercise

guidelines and Therapy. Physiotherapy Lab provides the necessary training to meet the total range of patient care responsibilities involved in preventing disabilities and promoting restoration of function to the physically impaired, including Musculoskeletal, Neuromuscular disorders that interfere with the physical function. It includes prescription of Exercise Therapy with the aid of continuous Passive movement device, Electronic

Cervical and Lumbar Traction Unit, Moist Heat Therapy and Paraffin Wax Bath, Manual Therapy, Electrotherapy treatment.



n) Radiography laboratory: Our radiography lab features one mobile X-ray unit, X-ray table with grid facility, X-ray chest stand with required PPE for radiation protection. Students Also have X-ray dark room and various accessories to assist them in learning the proper methods of producing quality radiographs.

i) **Medical Laboratory:** Biochemical, Pathological & Microbiological tests are carried out on clinical specimens to obtain information about the health of a patient to aid in diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of disease.





**j) Computer Laboratory:** Computer science and Information Technology which is very essential for students are to be taught with practical.

#### **LIBRARY HALL:**

Our Library is well-furnished and automated one with reference Books/journal with seating capacity of 50 students at a time Teaching aids and reference books are available for faculty members.



#### **AUDIO VISUAL ROOM:**



In order to make teaching learning process more attractive, there are audio-visual rooms. Advance training aids like chalk boards, overhead projector, slide, film projectors, modes, specimen, charts posters, Photostat machine and computers are provided.

#### **CONFERENCE HALL/AUDITORIUM:**

There is provision of a well-equipped digital Conference Hall/ Auditorium for our students with all the modern amenities that will serve the purpose of conferences, meetings, seminars, workshop and others functions. At times, it will serve the purpose for the Government meetings as and when required.




#### **TRANSPORT:**

The institution is having its own transport facilities to carry the students from hostel to the institutes and to different hospitals for clinical and practical demonstrations. Students are also provided with transportation for study Tour, Health camps, Workshops etc. Weekly transport facility will be provided to the students for the purpose of marketing, amusement and refreshment during holydays.

#### **HOSTEL:**

Hostel facility is available for both boy and girl students for the whole period of training enrolled. #### **RAGGING MENACE**

Ragging is a disturbing reality in the higher education system of our country. Despite the fact that over the years, ragging has claimed hundreds of innocent lives and has ruined the careers of thousands of bright students, the practice is still perceived by many as a way of 'familiarisation' and an 'initiation' into the real world for young college-going students.



Ragging is defined as any disorderly conduct, whether by words or written or by any an act, has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student. Indulging in a rowdy or undisciplined activity that causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or junior student. Asking the students to do any act or perform something that such students will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or junior student. This can lead to adverse effects such as depression, anxiety, and sometimes even suicide.

#### **Punishment provisions:**

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or off campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

- 1. Debarring from appearing from ant sessional test/ university examination or withholding results.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- 3. Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits.
- 4. Suspension from the college for a period of one month.
- 5. Cancellation of admission.
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 7. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
- 8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semester or equivalent period.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- 10. To fine upto ₹ 25,000/- (twenty five thousand only).
- 11. Imprisonment for a time which may extend to 2 years or with fine, which may extend to ₹ 10,000/- (ten thousand only) or both.
- 12. Collective punishment when the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
- Any institution that fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or fails to act in accordance with the Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators or incidence of ragging suitably liable to the penalties and punishments as per the provisions of the Regulations.

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS:**



- All complaints should be registered through proper channel. Students should maintain peace, harmony, integrity and discipline during their stay in the hostel and Institution.

#### **Grievance Redresal**

• Student can lodge their grievance through website or through manual system for which complaint boxes have been provided in the institution

#### **Cleanliness:**

- Classroom should be kept clean and tidy

• For any breakage or damage caused by student, the management has the right to deduct equal amount of money from the security deposit.

- After completion of course/internship, students are required to submit the I-cards to the principal.

- Students are not allowed to stay out overnight without permission and will be suspended from the institution if found doing so.

NEPNI Trust waves admission fees, hostel fees to deserving meritorious BPL Category students.



Healthcare has now been a primary focus of the Govt, both at state and central level, putting lot of efforts in terms of setting more infrastructures across the country, coupled with deployment of huge manpower. The private sector is also not lagging behind in this regard. It appears that there is still a large section of people of the country, particularly belonging to north eastern states facing problems in getting proper health care. Guwahati has become the hub of treatment to people coming from the entire north eastern states. Patients throng to Guwahati based Hospitals to get better treatment. Most of them fly to Chennai, New Delhi, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Mumbai with the perception that the facilities are better there than they are in Guwahati. Treatment outside the state of Assam is possible for those who are financially affluent and can afford the cost.



What major concern for the people of middle class, not to speak of weaker section, of the northern and western part of Assam is that cost of treatment in Guwahati based Private Hospitals is not affordable for them at all. The other aspect of great concern is that accessibility to Guwahati from surrounding area, especially from the north and western part of Assam has been a great challenge because of high rise in traffic coupled with frequent disruption of communication particularly during rainy season. Almost all the hospitals are located at the heart of the city making it more difficult for people to access from outside.

The least but not the last reason as to why there is a need of multispeciality Hospital at Alikash, the centre place of Kamrup District is that service quality in most of the Guwahati based Hospital is deteriorating even if the cost is very high. Credibility on these institutions has gone down day by day driving most of the patients to outside the state.

NEPNI, therefore has contemplated to go for setting up of a hospital at Alikash, in the district of Kamrup, just a few kilometres north of Guwahati with desired facilities to provide better health care at affordable cost. The NEPNI Hospital will serve as general Hospital catering to the need for high end, secondary and tertiary care. The Hospital will aim at putting the patient at the centre of care. Patient Centeredness... its vision is to deliver high quality Health care services.

The proposed hospital will be a multispecialty one with at least 100 beds to start with. The number of beds will be increased in near future.
